A few suggestions for using this course:

- The answers for most of the questions are to be found within the Bible passage being considered. If you find some question(s) difficult to answer move on to following questions until you have opportunity to consult with others or my "answers".
- For group study provide each member of the class with a copy of the lesson the week before the study is due. This will allow them time to study the passage and prepare their answers to the questions in order to be ready to participate in the Bible Study Class.
- If the class participates freely in prolonged discussion and conversation about the questions it may be better to divide each lesson into two and only do five questions at each study. That way your course will last twice as long!
